## 2024 Tech High School Alumnus of the Year Award, **Trey A. Lyles**

This year's Alumnus of the year is outstanding Tech student and athlete, Trey A. Lyles. Mr. Lyles graduated with the Class of 2014. A product of the New Tech High program, was a four-year honor student, making him part of the prestigious Top 25 group for his Tech graduating class. He was also a member of the Tech Legion and the National Honor Society.

Entering his senior year of high school in India-

napolis, Trey was ranked as one of the best high school basketball players in the U.S. and was recruited heavily by multiple universities.

During his senior year at Tech, Trey averaged 23 points, 13 rebounds, and 3 assists per game. He helped lead the boys' basketball team to the IHSAA Class 4A State Championship. His accolades include the Trester Award, Indiana Mr. Basketball, McDonald's All-American, and Indiana's Gatorade Player of the Year.



During the 2014-2015 school year Trey attended the University of Kentucky. He was named to the 2015 All-SEC Freshman Team and helped lead the UK Wildcats to a 2015 NCAA Final Four appearance.

In 2015 Trey was drafted by the Utah Jazz as the 12th overall pick in the NBA draft. He played two seasons for Utah followed by two seasons for the Denver Nuggets. He then played for two seasons each for the San Antonio Spurs and the Detroit Pistons. In February 2022 he moved to the Sacramento Kings for whom he still plays. At the beginning of this year (2024) he partnered with the Sacramento Public Library on a book club to encourage reading.

Trey generously gives of his time and treasure to Tech and the Tech Community. He comes back regularly to his alma mater to sponsor basketball camps, supporting both the girls' and boys' basketball teams.

His first year as an NBA pro he donated new basketball uniforms to the Tech Athletic Department. This year during the NBA All-Star weekend here in Indianapolis, he sponsored and participated in an All-Star Youth Camp hosted at Tech.

It should be noted that Trey has dual US – Canadian citizenship. As a result, he could potentially be a member of the Canadian 2024 Olympic Team. We wish Trey the best of luck in his commitment to participate in Team Canada.

## Centennial Museum Update

Tim Schneider '69, Museum Director

We have made great progress in reimagining and reorganizing the ATHS Alumni Centennial Museum. Furniture and artifacts have been moved to new locations and different rooms, and some artifacts have been archived as reference materials. We received donations of twelve display cases from Indianapolis Museum of Art at Newfields. They

include four 8 feet long angled-surface tables with glass lids, one 7 feet tall case with vitrine (a glass, plexiglass, or lucite box that protects the artifact it covers), three wall hanging vitrine cases, three podiums

> with vitrines, and one large freestanding vitrine. The long glass covered tables, tall display case, and the standalone vitrine will protect fragile artifacts that have been over loved by inquisitive visitors. They will help extend the life of artifacts for many years to come.

Bill Buckley ('69), museum volunteer Randy Wilson ('70), and I transported the display cases with the loading help of Elliott Smith's staff at Newfields and unloading help from the maintenance and custodial staff at Tech. The larger piecwould

not fit onto the Media Center elevator and were forklifted around the building and up the hill to the front doors where

the center standpost had to be removed to get them through the doors and into the building. Once inside, two doors were removed

in order to get the pieces into the appropriate museum rooms. Thanks to museum volunteer Linda Hill ('68) for providing pizza that day.

The museum purchased two rolling stands that will hold four more hanging garments from alumni donors. We also purchased a



Another acquisition is a plasma cut steel map of Indiana with Robert (Clark '46) Indiana's LOVE cut into the heart of the state. It was donated and created by Daniel (Dano) Jones of Circle City Metalworks, son of Debbie Doll ('72). Art department faculty mem-

ber Jon Little is also creating a TECH piece in the style of Indiana's LOVE. These pieces, along with another, will hang with the Robert Indiana display exhibiting the homage spinoff items the famous LOVE sculpture gave birth to.

The Museum is currently open on Wednesdays from 10am to 2pm when school is in session and by appointment. It is currently staffed by four Tech Alums. That's four, despite Tech having graduated over 50,000 students.

Our 3,000+ square feet of artifacts and history should be open more than just four hours one day a week. If you can spare even two hours one day a week, it would be a great help. If you are interested in learning what being a museum volunteer involves, please
